

MOUND AMATEUR RADIO ASSOCIATION CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I NAME

- Section 1: The name of this organization shall be the Mound Amateur Radio Association, Inc. (M.A.R.A.)
- Section 2: The principle location of this organization shall be at 900 Mound Road, Miamisburg, Ohio.

ARTICLE II DEFINITIONS OF TERMS

- Section 1: A Club Member shall be defined as an individual whom was approved for membership by two-thirds (2/3) or greater vote of those active members present at a regular club meeting of the organization.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

- Section 1: The purpose of this organization shall be:
- A: To organize and train members to be capable of maintaining communications during emergencies and public service functions.
 - B: To promote interest and proficiency in the art of Amateur Radio Communications in the operational and experimental fields.
 - C: To encourage non-amateurs to become licensed by offering classes and exposure to amateur activities and encourage license upgrades of the membership.

ARTICLE IV MEMBERSHIP

- Section 1: Membership shall not be denied to anyone based on race, creed, sex, or religion.
- Section 2: Club membership cannot be granted until the individual has been voted on and has paid the annual dues. At that time, the individual shall have full active membership privileges.
- Section 3: Club members who fail to pay the annual dues shall be considered inactive.
- Section: 4 Only Active Club Members will be allowed to vote on club policies and procedures, or in elections.
